- The paper should not have been published or communicated for publication else where. Authors are solely responsible for the factual accuracy of their contribution. The data reported in the paper should not be older than 5 years. Paper should be divided into following sub-heading -
 - Title with authors name and address.
 - (b) Abstract should indicate the principal findings. It should not be more than
 - Key words: key words in italics should not exceed 4 or 5 words.
 - Introduction: should be brief and without headings. It should relate to the aim of the study.
 - Materials and methods : when methods are well known citation of the standard work is sufficient. All measurements should be in metric units.
 - Results and Discussion: The results should be supported by brief and adequate tables, graphs, charts and photographs wherever needed.
 - Tables and figures: should be given on seperate papers. Data can be given either in figures or tables but not in both. Figures, illustrations or photographs should be of good quality and suitable for final reduction allowing space for
 - References: should be arranged alphabetically without serial numbers as illustrated below :-
